## **RESERVOIR GUIDELINES**

- NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON PTRWA PROPERTY.
- NO FIREARMS ALLOWED ON PTRWA PROPERTY.
- 3. NC State fishing license required.
- 4. Fishing from boat or pier only. NO BANK FISHING
- 5. All boats must check in upon arrival and out at departure.
- 6. No gasoline powered boats north of Highway 62.
- 7. All US Coast Guard safety equipment required.
- 8. Maximum speed limit 25 mph.
- 9. No boat shall touch the shore except at approved area.
- 10. No boat shall be refueled in the water or within 200 feet of waters edge.
- 11. Every boat shall have a pail with cover for sanitary purposes only.
- 12. No boats within 300 feet of raw water intake line or water treatment plant.
- Minimum age to operate a gasoline powered boat is 16 years old.

- 14. No privately owned boat will be allowed to stay overnight.
- 15. A limit of 100 gasoline powered boats will be allowed at one time.
- 16. All boats must be off the water30 minutes prior to closing.
- 17. Large Mouth Bass must be at least 14 inches with a limit of 5 per day.
- 18. No cleaning of fish on PTRWA property.
- 19. Lake Warden has the right to check any boat at any time while on property.
- 20. Lake Warden has the authority to remove from or deny / refuse access to PTRWA property.
- 21. No one is allowed on buffer property at any time.
- 22. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times while on property and cleaned up after.
- 23. No swimming, skiing, tubing or jets skis will be allowed on lake.

The Executive Director of PTRWA has the authority to close the lake at any time.
